Topic

COL Hepner will give an overview of Fort Indiantown Gap and its capabilities as they relate to law enforcement agencies. LTC Collage will brief the capabilities of the Pennsylvania Counterdrug Joint Task Force (CJTF) and how it provides operational and training support to law enforcement. SFC Oswald will brief the training capabilities provided by the Northeast Counterdrug Training Center, which is part of the CJTF. MSgt Thornsberry will provide information regarding the CJTF's specific operational capabilities and how they support law enforcement.
